



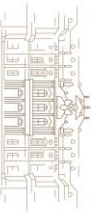

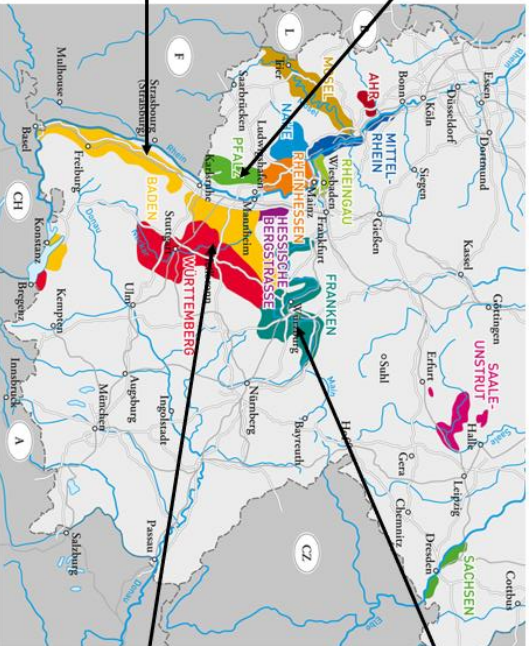

**Region: Baden - Ortenau - Black Forest.**  
**1948 - Own vineyards 260 ha – 350 growers**  
**Pinot noir – Riesling – Pinot Gris**

All work in the vineyard is done by hand as we have many steep slopes. We follow strict quality control both in the vineyard (yield reduction) and in the cellar. We use the traditional *methode champenoise* for our sparkling wine production. Our soils are mainly granite – a hard plutonic rock composed primarily of quartz, feldspar and other minerals.

**1930 - Own vineyards 400 ha – 250 growers**

**Region: Franken – Würzburg**  
**1128 – State of Bayern winery- VDP.**  
**Silvaner – Riesling – Pinot Blanc – Pinot Noir**

Excellency of Wine Franconia, owned by the Royal Court of the State of Bavaria. The cellars are in the World Heritage Site at the Würzburg Palace. One-third of our sites are classed as steep slopes. Grapes grown on ten different 1<sup>st</sup> growth sites covering all of Franken's soil types collectively known as Trias. Leading member of the .VDP Verband Prädikatsweingüter.

From entry level, to terroir-driven single-vineyards, up to our premium range grown on 125 ha; Riesling is our passion. All of our growers are from local families. Investment in cellar technology combined with traditional growing methods and careful crafting, reflects our origin and highest quality standards. Our soils are limestone rich, sandy loam, red sandstone

**Region: Württemberg – Clebronn**  
**1951 - Own vineyards 280 ha – 580 growers**  
**Lemberger – Trollinger – Riesling**

We are the quality leader in Württemberg – in 2012 we were awarded one of six awards by Gault Millau “Discovery of the Year” and consistently receive awards for “best-value for money”. We have over 80 wines in our portfolio. Our main red variety is Lemberger, we also produce Riesling and Rosés. The vines are mainly grown on keuper soil.
