Mouhtaro (100%)

12 months maturation in large oak barrels & 12 months in bottles

Land:

Mouhtaro vineyard (Royat formation)

at the Southern slopes of Helicon Mountain (top of 1280 meters high), in Muses Valley at 380-420m altitude.

The vines per HA are 4200

The soil is clay and gravel with 6-8% gradient

The vineyard is not irrigated

The average yield is 8000 Kgr / Ha

Plot name: Papanikolas

Wine:

Color is dark black ruby red.

Aromas of black fruit (black cherry, black berries of the forest), vanilla, chocolate, cacao, floral notes (violet) & sweet spice (cinnamon).

Acidity is refreshing, high with mellow and round tannins.

Taste is rich, creamy, layered, dense with flavors of black fruit, butter, caramel, chocolate & cinnamon.

Body is full with very long aftertaste.
