Land:

The vineyard (Rovat formation) was planted in 1989 at the Southern slopes of Helicon (top of 1280 meters high), in Muses Valley at 380-420m altitude.

The vines per HA are 4440

The soil is clay and gravel with 3-5% gradient

The vineyard is not irrigated

The average yield is 9000 Kgr / Ha

Wine:

Color is pale green with lemon notes.

Aromas of peach, mango and white pepper.

Acidity is refreshing, average to high

Taste of crispy peach and tropical fruits.

Body is light with long aftertaste.
